I am a registered Psychologist with clinical endorsement by the Psychology Board of Australia. I have experience working in primary healthcare, private practice and custodial settings with a focus on risk assessment and intervention.

Within these settings I have worked with clients using evidence-based therapy modalities such as cognitive behavioural therapy (CBT), dialectical behavioural therapy (DBT), motivational interviewing (MI), acceptance and commitment therapy (ACT) and schema therapy (ST). I have also facilitated group treatment for men who have committed domestic violence offences.

I have conducted assessments and provided treatment to people who experience a complex range of presenting concerns such as serious mental illness, personality disorders and drug and alcohol dependence as well as offending behaviours. In addition to this, I also have experience providing evidence based individual treatment for a broad range of clinical presentations such as stress, mood disorders, relationship difficulties, anger management/emotion regulation difficulties, gender identity and sexuality difficulties and neuro-divergent presentations. I have particular interest in working with clients who identify as part of the LGBTQI+ community, people who have experienced complex trauma and people who experiencing difficulties associated with drug and alcohol use.

I have experience in providing individual and peer supervision to Mental Health Social Workers, Provisional Psychologists and registered Psychologists. I have also held roles as Clinical Manager, Clinical Advisor and Team Leader within primary care settings providing clinical guidance, training and assessment.
